

FORTIX END USER AGREEMENT

BY SIGNING THE FORTIX QUOTATION AS PART OF THE ORDERING PROCESS, YOU AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS (THE "AGREEMENT") GOVERNING YOUR USE OF FORTIX'S ONLINE SERVICE (THE "SERVICE"). IF YOU ARE ENTERING INTO THIS AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF A COMPANY OR OTHER LEGAL ENTITY, YOU REPRESENT THAT YOU HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO BIND SUCH ENTITY TO THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS, IN WHICH CASE THE TERMS "YOU" OR "YOUR" SHALL REFER TO SUCH ENTITY. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE SUCH AUTHORITY, OR IF YOU DO NOT AGREE WITH THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS, YOU MUST NOT PROCEED AND MAY NOT USE THE SERVICE.

As part of the Service, Fortix will provide you with use of the Service, including a browser interface, plug-in into some 3rd party products, web services access and data encryption, transmission, access and storage. Your registration for, or use of, the Service shall be deemed to be your agreement to abide by this Agreement including any materials available on the Fortix website incorporated by reference herein, including but not limited to Fortix's privacy and security policies. For reference, a Definitions section is included at the end of this Agreement.

1. Privacy & Security; Disclosure

Fortix's privacy policies may be viewed at <http://www.fortix.com.au/privacypolicy>. Fortix reserves the right to modify its privacy and security policies in its reasonable discretion from time to time. Individual users when they initially log in, will be asked whether or not they wish to receive marketing, weekly reports and other non-critical Service-related communications from Fortix from time to time. They may opt out of receiving such communications at that time or at any subsequent time by choosing the unsubscribe link from such communication. Note that because the Service is a hosted, online application, Fortix occasionally may need to notify all users of the Service (whether or not they have opted out as described above) of important announcements regarding the operation of the Service.

2. License Grant & Restrictions

Fortix hereby grants you a non-exclusive, non-transferable, worldwide right to use the Service, solely for your own internal business purposes, subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement. All rights not expressly granted to you are reserved by Fortix and its licensors.

You shall not (i) license, sublicense, sell, resell, transfer, assign, distribute or otherwise commercially exploit or make available to any third party the Service or the Content in any way; (ii) modify, amend, alter, copy, or in any

other way vary or make derivative works based upon the Service or the Content; (iii) create Internet "links" to the Service or "frame" or "mirror" any Content on any other server or wireless or Internet-based device; or (iv) reverse engineer or access the Service in order to (a) build a competitive product or service, (b) build a product using similar ideas, features, functions or graphics of the Service, or (c) copy any ideas, features, functions or graphics of the Service. Service is supplied with unlimited User licenses.

You may use the Service only for your internal business purposes and shall not: (i) send spam or otherwise duplicative or unsolicited messages in violation of applicable laws; (ii) send or store infringing, obscene, threatening, libelous, or otherwise unlawful or tortious material, including material harmful to children or violative of third party privacy rights; (iii) send or store material containing software viruses, worms, Trojan horses or other harmful computer code, files, scripts, agents or programs; (iv) interfere with or disrupt the integrity or performance of the Service or the data contained therein; (v) attempt to gain unauthorized access to the Service or its related systems or networks; or (vi) breach any of the rules or conditions of use for the Service that Fortix shall publish from time to time.

3. Your Responsibilities

You are responsible for all activity occurring under your User accounts and shall abide by all applicable local, state, national and foreign laws, treaties and regulations in connection with your use of the Service, including those related to data privacy, international communications and the transmission of technical or personal data. You shall: (i) notify Fortix immediately of any unauthorized use of any password or account or any other known or suspected breach of security; (ii) report to Fortix immediately and use reasonable efforts to stop immediately any copying or distribution of Content that is known or suspected by you or your Users; and (iii) not impersonate another Fortix user or provide false identity information to gain access to or use the Service.

4. Account Information and Data

Fortix will make best endeavors to backup Customer Data every 24 hours. Fortix will not at any time retrieve Customer Data if it is accidentally or otherwise delete by you. In the unlikely case where Customer Data is lost because of software or hardware malfunction, Fortix will endeavor to restore to the most recent successful backup. Fortix takes no responsibility whatsoever whether implied or otherwise for the quality or frequency of Customer Data backup. Fortix shall not be liable for any losses, damages, including any consequential damages, costs, expenses or any other outgoing that may be incurred by you as a result of any data being lost because of software or hardware malfunction.

Fortix does not own any data, information or material that you submit to the Service in the course of using the Service ("Customer Data"). You, not Fortix, shall have sole responsibility for the input accuracy, quality, integrity, legality, reliability, appropriateness, and intellectual property ownership or right to use of all Customer Data, and Fortix shall not be responsible or liable for the deletion, correction, destruction, damage, loss or failure to store any Customer Data. In the event this Agreement is terminated (other than by reason of your breach), Fortix will make available to you a file of the Customer Data within 30 days of termination if you so request at the time of termination. Fortix reserves the right to withhold, remove and/or discard Customer Data without notice for any breach, including, without limitation, your non-payment. Upon termination for cause, your right to access or use Customer Data immediately ceases, and Fortix shall have no obligation to maintain or forward any Customer Data.

During your use of the Service, Fortix will archive certain information as well as keep some usage and statistical information. In all cases Fortix reserves the right to delete archived, usage and statistical data irretrievably once it is older than three (3) months. Fortix shall not be liable for any loss, damage, including any consequential damages, cost, expense or any outgoing of whatsoever nature that may be incurred by you as a result of Fortix deleting archived usage and statistical data.

5. Intellectual Property Ownership

Fortix alone (and its licensors, where applicable) shall own all right, title and interest, including all related Intellectual Property Rights, in and to the Fortix Technology, the Content and the Service and any suggestions, ideas, enhancement requests, feedback, recommendations or other information provided by you or any other party relating to the Service. This Agreement is not a sale and does not convey to you any rights of ownership in or related to the Service, the Fortix Technology or the Intellectual Property Rights owned by Fortix. The Fortix name, the Fortix logo, and the product names associated with the Service are trademarks of Fortix or third parties, and no right or license is granted to use them. You are only able to use the Service and the content on the terms and conditions as set out in this Agreement.

6. Third Party Interactions

During use of the Service, you may enter into correspondence with, purchase goods and/or services from, or participate in promotions of advertisers or sponsors showing their goods and/or services through the Service. Any such activity, and any terms, conditions, warranties or representations associated with such activity, is solely between you and the applicable third-party. Fortix and its licensors shall have no liability, obligation or responsibility for any such correspondence, purchase or promotion between you and any such third-party. Fortix does not endorse any sites on the Internet that are linked through the Service. Fortix

provides these links to you only as a matter of convenience, and in no event shall Fortix or its licensors be responsible for any content, products, or other materials on or available from such sites. Fortix provides the Service to you pursuant to the terms and conditions of this Agreement. You recognize, however, that certain third-party providers of ancillary software, hardware or services may require your agreement to additional or different license or other terms prior to your use of or access to such software, hardware or services. Fortix shall not be liable for any losses, damages, including consequential damages, costs, expenses or outgoings of whatsoever nature that you may incur by dealing with any advertiser or sponsor or the acquisition of any goods or services or participation in any promotion through the Services.

7. Charges and Payment of Fees

You shall pay all fees or charges to your account in accordance with the setup and ongoing fees and charges, and billing terms in effect at the time a fee or charge is due and payable. The amount payable will be equal to the setup and ongoing charges related to your plan plus any excess number of total User licenses requested times the per User license fee currently in effect. Payments may be made, in advance, monthly, half-yearly or annually, consistent with the Initial Term (the first License Term), or as otherwise mutually agreed upon. You are responsible for paying for all User licenses ordered for the entire License Term, whether or not such User licenses are actively used. You must provide Fortix with approved purchase order information as a condition to signing up for the Service.

Pricing schedule is outlined in the written proposal.

Fortix reserves the right to modify its fees and charges and to introduce new charges at any time, upon at least 30 days prior notice to you, which notice may be provided by email. All pricing terms are confidential, and you agree not to disclose them to any third party. Any and all fees paid in advance are not refundable if you cease to use the Service.

8. Limits and Excess Fees

The maximum disk storage space provided to you at no additional charge is dependent on the plan that you choose. If the amount of disk storage required exceeds these limits, you will be charged the then-current storage fees.

The maximum amount of incoming traffic to your website is 10GB per month. Fortix reserves the right to negotiate an increased monthly fee effective from the next billing period should this ratio be exceeded.

Any failure by Fortix to so notify you shall not affect your responsibility for such additional storage and traffic charges. Fortix reserves the right to

establish or modify its general practices and limits relating to storage of and traffic relating to Customer Data.

9. Billing and Renewal

Fortix charges and collects in advance for use of the Service. Fortix will automatically renew the License Term and bill your credit card or issue an invoice to you (a) every month for monthly licenses, (b) every 6-months for half-yearly licenses, (c) each year on the subsequent anniversary for annual licenses, or (d) as otherwise mutually agreed upon. The renewal charge will be equal to the then-current plan fee plus any excess User licenses times the user license fee in effect during the prior term, unless Fortix has given you at least 30 days prior written notice of a fee change, which shall be effective upon renewal and thereafter. Fees for other services will be charged on an as-quoted basis. Fortix's fees are exclusive of all taxes, levies, or duties imposed by taxing authorities, and you shall be responsible for payment of all such taxes, levies, or duties.

You agree to provide Fortix with complete and accurate billing and contact information. This information includes your legal company name, street address, email address, and name and telephone number of an authorized billing contact and License Administrator. You agree to update this information within 30 days of any change to it. If the contact information you have provided is false or fraudulent, Fortix reserves the right to terminate your access to the Service in addition to any other legal remedies.

Unless Fortix in its discretion determines otherwise: (i) entities with headquarters in United States will be billed in U.S. dollars ("U.S. Customers"); (ii) entities with headquarters in Australia will be billed in Australian dollars; and (iii) all other entities will be billed in U.S. dollars, Euros or local currency (if available) ("Non-U.S./Australia Customers").

If you believe your bill is incorrect, you must contact us in writing within 60 days of the invoice date of the invoice containing the amount in question to be eligible to receive an adjustment or credit.

10. Non-Payment and Suspension

In addition to any other rights granted to Fortix herein, Fortix reserves the right to suspend or terminate this Agreement and your access to the Service, if your account becomes delinquent (falls into arrears). Access to the Administration interface will be suspended immediately if an invoice is delinquent and is re-enabled when such delinquent invoices are paid in full. Fortix reserves the right to suspend or terminate your public website if delinquent invoices are 60 days overdue. Fortix shall be entitled to charge interest on any monies that are not paid by the due date at the rate of interest that is 2% greater than the rate of interest charged by Fortix's bank on overdrafts of greater than \$100,000.00, together with any costs incurred

by Fortix in recovering the monies, including any legal costs that may be incurred calculated on an indemnity basis. You will continue to be charged for User licenses during any period of suspension. If you or Fortix initiates termination of this Agreement, you will be obligated to pay the balance due on your account computed in accordance with the Charges and Payment of Fees section above. You agree that Fortix may charge such unpaid fees to your credit card or otherwise bill you for such unpaid fees.

Fortix reserves the right to impose a reconnection fee in the event you are suspended and thereafter request access to the Service. You agree and acknowledge that Fortix has no obligation to retain Customer Data and that such Customer Data may be irretrievably deleted if your account is 30 days or more delinquent. Fortix shall not be liable for any losses, damages, including any consequential damages, costs, expenses or any outgoings of whatsoever nature that you may incur as a result of Fortix suspending or terminating your account as a result of your account becoming delinquent.

11. Termination upon Expiration/Reduction in Number of Licenses

This Agreement commences on the Effective Date. The Initial Term (the first License Term) will be one year or as otherwise mutually agreed upon. Your obligation to pay for the service begins from the Effective Date and invoices must be paid according to the then current payment terms. Access to the Administration interface will be suspended immediately if an invoice is delinquent. Upon the expiration of the Initial Term, this Agreement will automatically renew for a successive License Term equal in duration to the Initial Term (or one year, if the Initial Term is greater than one year) at Fortix's then current fees, and payable in advance. Either party may terminate this Agreement, effective only upon the expiration of the then current License Term, by notifying the other party in writing at least fourteen (14) business days prior to the date of the invoice for the following term. In the case of free trials, notifications provided through the Service indicating the remaining number of days in the free trial shall constitute notice of termination. In the event this Agreement is terminated (other than by reason of your breach), Fortix will make available to you a file of the Customer Data within 30 days of termination if you so request at the time of termination. You agree and acknowledge that Fortix has no obligation to retain the Customer Data, and may delete such Customer Data irretrievably, more than 30 days after termination. Fortix shall not be liable for any loss, damage, including consequential damage, cost, expense or outgoing of whatsoever nature that you may incur as a result of Fortix deleting any customer data after 30 days after termination.

12. Termination for Cause

Any breach of your payment obligations or unauthorized use of the Fortix Technology or Service will be deemed a material breach of this Agreement. Fortix, in its sole discretion, may terminate your password, account or use of the Service if you breach or otherwise fail to comply with this Agreement. In addition, Fortix may terminate a free account at any time in its sole discretion. You agree and acknowledge that Fortix has no obligation to retain the Customer Data, and may delete such Customer Data, if you have materially breached this Agreement, including but not limited to failure to pay outstanding fees, and such breach has not been cured within 30 days of notice of such breach. Fortix shall not be liable for any loss, damage, including consequential damage, cost, expense or outgoing of whatsoever nature that may be incurred by you as a result of Fortix undertaking any of the matters as set out in this paragraph.

13. Subscribing to Extra Services

As part of the Service, you may be able to subscribe to extra features such as real-time application monitoring and custom feature development. Each service may have a fixed monthly charge as well as data usage charges. In the case where usage charges apply, these will be calculated automatically and billed at the end of each calendar month or as mutually agreed based on the then-current Fortix pricing.

14. Service Level Agreement

The service level comprises of your ability to access Customer Data via a web-browser interface and any other reliability, timeliness, quality, suitability, truth, availability or completeness of the Service is not covered in this agreement. Scheduled downtimes are set between the hours of 2000 to 0600 (AEST). In the unlikely event where Service Level Agreements are not met for any given month, a pro-rata rebate will be applied against the next License Term period. Normal billing will resume from the following period. No rebate applies nor is payable if no future billing period exists.

Fortix will use best endeavors to ensure the delivery of real-time alerts. Fortix guarantees to send real-time alerts instantly but cannot guarantee their delivery by 3rd party providers and aggregators. Fortix shall not be liable to you for any losses, damages, including consequential damages, costs, expenses or outgoings of whatsoever nature arising out of in connection with any breach by Fortix of this clause.

Email marketing broadcasts will be undertaken at anytime during the date specified for the broadcast and may take up to 24 hours to deliver from commencement of the broadcast.

15. Marketing

You grant Fortix the right to display your brand including company name and logo on its website and other marketing communications.

16. Representations & Warranties

Each party represents and warrants that it has the legal power and authority to enter into this Agreement. Fortix represents and warrants that it will provide the Service in a manner consistent with general industry standards reasonably applicable to the provision thereof and that the Service will perform substantially in accordance with the online Fortix help documentation under normal use and circumstances. You represent and warrant that you have not falsely identified yourself nor provided any false information to gain access to the Service and that your billing information is correct.

17. Mutual Indemnification

You shall indemnify and hold Fortix, its licensors and each such party's parent organizations, subsidiaries, affiliates, officers, directors, employees, solicitors' and agents harmless from and against any and all claims, costs, damages, losses, liabilities and expenses (including legal fees calculated on an indemnity basis) arising out of or in connection with: (i) a claim alleging that use of the Customer Data infringes the rights of, or has caused harm to, a third party; (ii) a claim, which if true, would constitute a violation by you of your representations and warranties; or (iii) a claim arising from the breach by you or your Users of this Agreement, provided in any such case that Fortix (a) gives written notice of the claim promptly to you; (b) gives you sole control of the defense and settlement of the claim (provided that you may not settle or defend any claim unless you unconditionally release Fortix of all liability and such settlement does not affect Fortix's business or Service); (c) provides to you all available information and assistance; and (d) has not compromised or settled such claim.

Fortix shall indemnify and hold you and your parent organizations, subsidiaries, affiliates, officers, directors, employees, solicitors and agents harmless from and against any and all claims, costs, damages, losses, liabilities and expenses (including legal fees calculated on an indemnity basis) arising out of or in connection with: (i) a claim alleging that the Service directly infringes a copyright or a trademark of a third party, a U.S. patent issued as of the Effective Date; (ii) a claim, which if true, would constitute a violation by Fortix of its representations or warranties; or (iii) a claim arising from breach of this Agreement by Fortix; provided that you (a) promptly give written notice of the claim to Fortix; (b) give Fortix sole control of the defense and settlement of the claim (provided that Fortix may not settle or defend any claim unless it unconditionally releases you of all liability); (c) provide to Fortix all available information and assistance; and (d) have not compromised or settled such claim. Fortix shall have no indemnification obligation, and you shall indemnify Fortix pursuant to this

Agreement, for claims arising from any infringement arising from the combination of the Service with any of your products, service, hardware or business process(s).

18. Disclaimer of Warranties

EXCEPT FOR WHAT IS STATED IN SECTION 14 FORTIX AND ITS LICENSORS MAKE NO REPRESENTATION, WARRANTY, OR GUARANTEE AS TO THE RELIABILITY, TIMELINESS, QUALITY, SUITABILITY, TRUTH, AVAILABILITY, ACCURACY OR COMPLETENESS OF THE SERVICE OR ANY CONTENT EXCEPT FOR WHAT IS STATED. EXCEPT FOR WHAT IS STATED IN SECTION 14 FORTIX'S SERVICES MAY BE SUBJECT TO LIMITATIONS, DELAYS, AND OTHER PROBLEMS INHERENT IN THE USE OF THE INTERNET AND ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS. FORTIX IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DELAYS, DELIVERY FAILURES, OR OTHER DAMAGE RESULTING FROM SUCH PROBLEMS.

20. Limitation of Liability

IN NO EVENT SHALL EITHER PARTY'S AGGREGATE LIABILITY EXCEED THE AMOUNTS ACTUALLY PAID BY AND/OR DUE FROM YOU IN THE TWELVE (12) MONTH PERIOD IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE EVENT GIVING RISE TO SUCH CLAIM. IN NO

You are responsible for regularly reviewing this Agreement. Continued use of the Service after any such changes shall constitute your consent to such changes.

25. Assignment: Change in Control

This Agreement may not be assigned by you without the prior written approval of Fortix. Fortix shall not unreasonably withhold its approval to a proposed assignee who is, in the opinion of Fortix, financially sound, has

the business acumen and capacity to perform the terms and conditions of this Agreement, and enters into an agreement agreeing to be bound by the terms and conditions of this Agreement and at the time of the proposed assignment you are not in breach of any of the terms and conditions of this Agreement. Fortix may assign this Agreement without your consent to (i) a parent or subsidiary, (ii) an acquirer of assets, or (iii) a successor by merger. Any purported assignment in violation of this section shall be void. Any actual or proposed change in control of you that results or would result in a direct competitor of Fortix directly or indirectly owning or controlling 50% or more of you shall entitle Fortix to terminate this Agreement for cause immediately upon written notice.

26. General

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of Western Australia, without regard to the choice or conflicts of law provisions of any jurisdiction, and any disputes, actions, claims or causes of action arising out of or in connection with this Agreement or the Service shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the state and federal courts located in WA Australia. No text or information set forth on any other purchase order, preprinted form or document (other than an Order Form, if applicable) shall add to or vary the terms and conditions of this Agreement. If any provision of this Agreement is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable, then such provision(s) shall be construed, as nearly as possible, to reflect the intentions of the invalid or unenforceable provision(s), with all other provisions remaining in full force and effect.

No joint venture, partnership, employment, or agency relationship exists between you and Fortix as a result of this agreement or use of the Service. The failure of Fortix to enforce any right or provision in this Agreement shall not constitute a waiver of such right or provision unless acknowledged and agreed to by Fortix in writing.
